8:30 AM – Start Market Livestock Viewing area for attendees

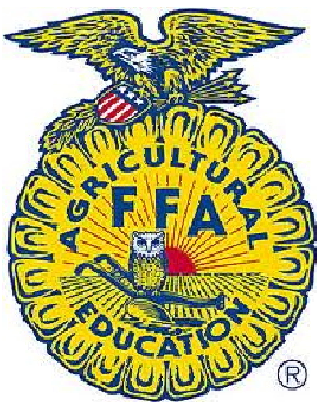
11-1 PM – Stevens County Farmers and FFA members will Grill Cheeseburgers for all students, staff and attendees of our event.
